What is a Social Cooperative/Enterprise?

- A **no profit** enterprise built to provide services to persons with **disadvantages** (seniors, mental physical disabled, young at risk of deviance, etc.) or
- Built **by** persons with **disadvantages** (ex-offenders, physical/mental disabled, drug-addicts, seniors, long term unemployed, etc.) to produce **products/provide services**;
- **Cooperative methods**: peer-to-peer/ internal democracy (less strong in Social Enterprises)

What ASIS is

- ASIS (founded on **2005**) is a *Geo-Community Consortium* made by Consortia of Social Cooperatives from the Regione Campania (South of Italy, Naples);
- ASIS' members: **5 local Consortia** of Social Cooperatives + **CGM** (Consorzio Gino Mattarelli - National Network of Social Cooperatives);
- It is indirectly and directly in contact with more than **70 social cooperatives/enterprises** from the territory;

Aims of ASIS

to **support** Consortia and social cooperatives in processes of **social innovation**

The European Vision

The back idea is that:

- a) local social entrepreneurship and social cooperation need to exchange good practices, information and knowledge even at EU level;
- b) Knowledge of different models, the joint European creation of new “social” models stimulates the qualitative growth of local social cooperation/entrepreneurship
- c) Some innovation fields (i.e.: alternative energies, co-housing, health-care, tourism) pretend a wider perspective/approach.
